

# Sanlúcar AND ITS ENVIRONMENT

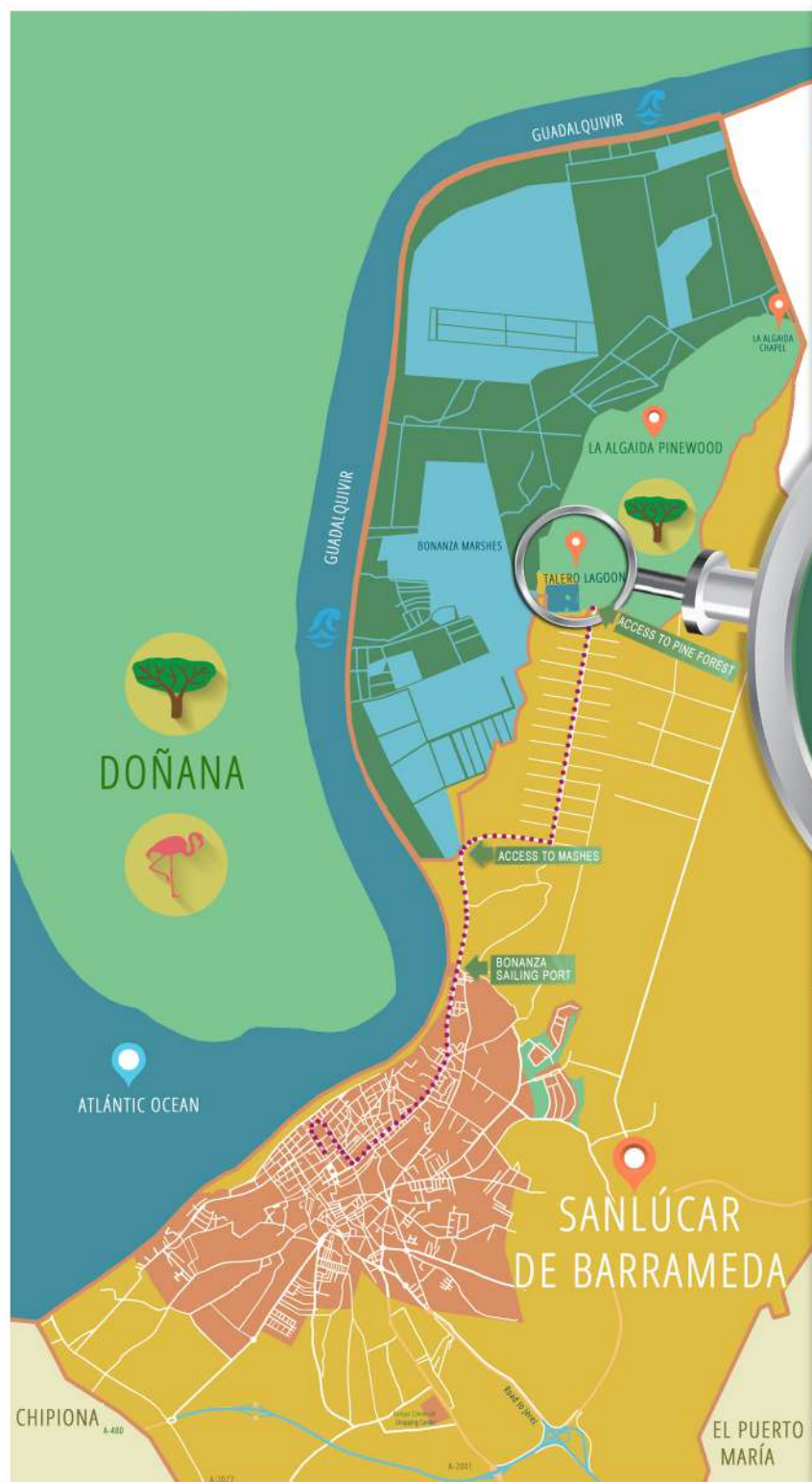

## PINE FOREST OF LA ALGAIDA

Coordinates: 36° 50'50" N 6° 18'55" W

It is located in the Doñana Natural Area, next to the agricultural colony of Monte Algaida, within the municipality of Sanlúcar. The access from the southern part is communicated through the colony of Monte Algaida and the Bonanza district with the town of Sanlúcar.

Near the southern access the trail called "Cerro del Águila" begins. It is an easy circular route of about 5 kms.
